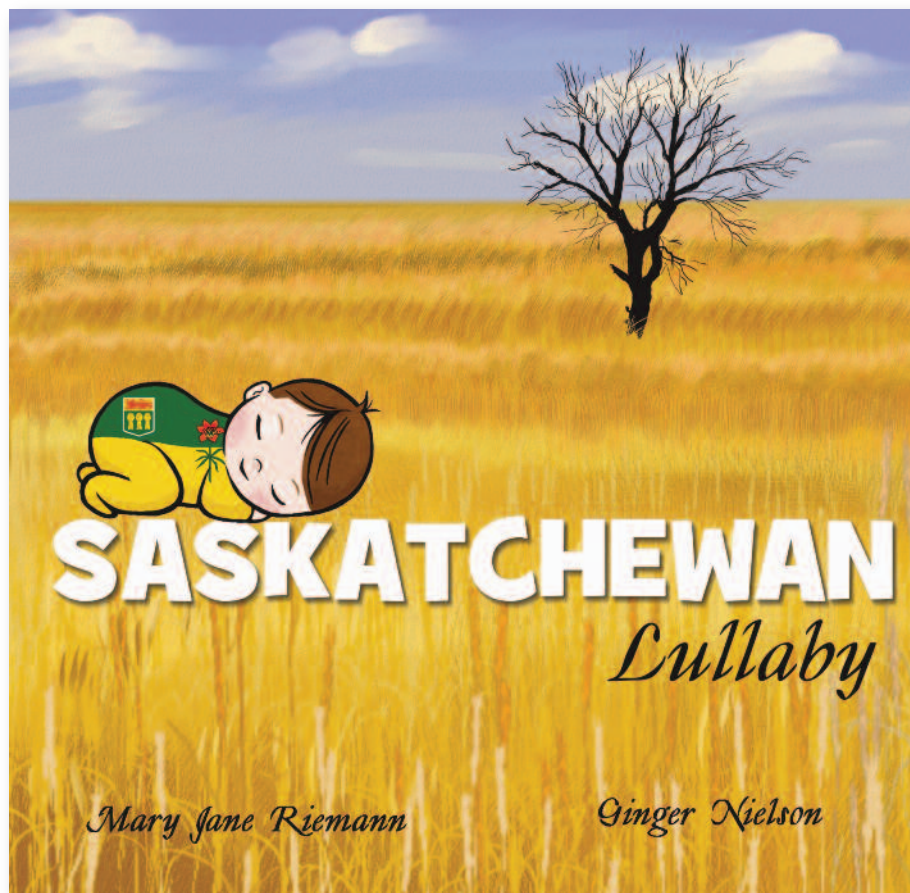


SASKATCHEWAN LULLABY
